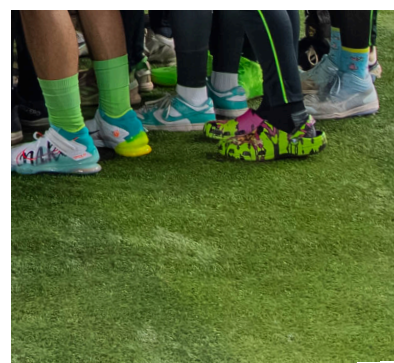

A NOTE FROM OUR CEO

2024 was the first full year with Bananas Foster. A season that led to the decision to commit to having a Bananas Foster Family (BFF) celebration at every single Banana Ball game, no matter the team. **This was the year we committed to be the nonprofit not just of the Savannah Bananas, but of Banana Ball.**

This year, we challenged our organization and tested out the ‘split tour’ and had two games occur at one time. This tour led to double the foster family celebrations, double the awareness, and double the impact! Speaking of impact, 2024 was the year we played at our first MLB Ballparks. In total, we played at 6 MLBs: Houston, Boston, Washington D.C., Cleveland, Philadelphia, and Miami.

Foster care is a topic that isn’t talked about much in society and we are still trying to change that. Our vision is to create a surplus of families who are waiting in the wings, patient if their services weren’t needed immediately, but confidently showing up as soon as they were requested... a waitlist of foster families.

If we have a surplus of foster families, then the children who come into care will be placed with the right family for them to walk through trauma with. A family who can speak the same language as the children, who can bond over similar passions, who lives in the same city. These things seem simple, but currently, are so far from how we children come into care because of the lack of foster families.

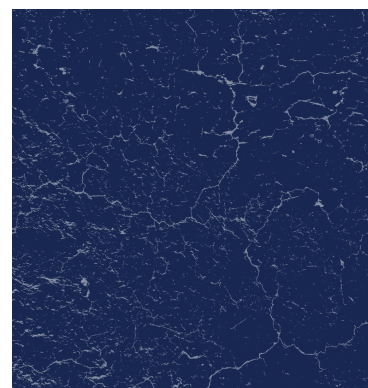
In 2024, we celebrated 93 foster families. At every game, we find more people inspired to get involved. We are proud to connect people with organizations to make a difference in the foster care community.

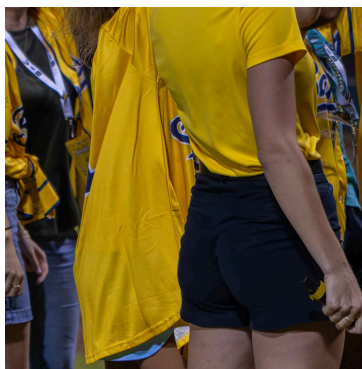
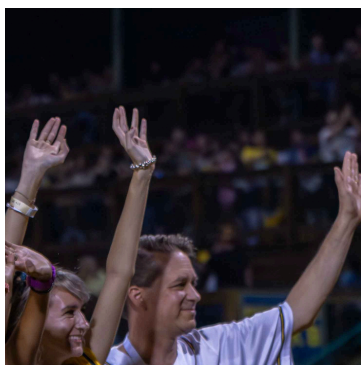
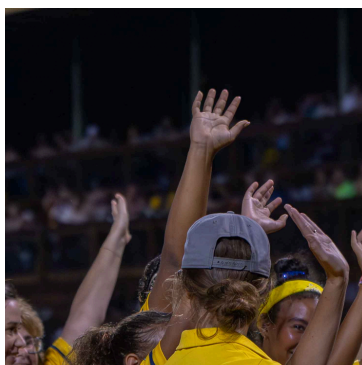
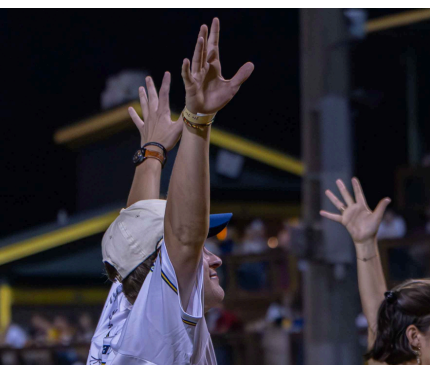
OUR MISSION

As the official nonprofit of Banana Ball, we are using our platform to raise awareness for the foster care community. In the United States, there are over 400,000 children and teens in foster care. There are many ways to get involved and not everyone has the ability to become a foster parent, but everyone has the ability to help those experiencing foster care.

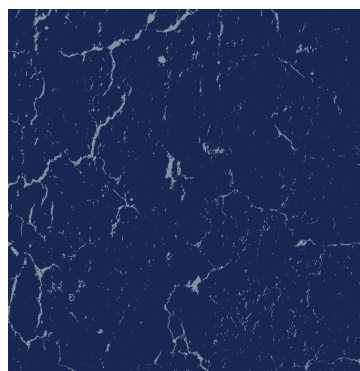

I'm not sure I even have the describable words to write for this moment. Two lost and lonely siblings who experienced the greatest loss in their lives yet continued to do the right things in their own journeys. This is love... this is brotherhood...this is a hole healed that statistically should never be.

March 16, 2024 will never be forgotten due to Bananas Foster, The Savannah Bananas, The Party Animals, and this entire organization for believing in us and giving our inner children this chance.

Potassium CARE Baskets

To support those making a difference in the foster care community, we created the Potassium CARE Basket program. These baskets are designed to provide support based on their needs. For example, we know a family that said yes to an infant in their home. So, when our team put together their Potassium CARE Basket it was filled with diapers, age-appropriate clothing, and additional needs for the caretakers.

Potassium CARE Baskets are given to those making a difference and personalized based on their needs. Whether you are licensed for 20 years or 20 days, we send a basket to say ‘Thank You’ and to show our support.

**Please note revenue and expenses are calculated from January 1 - December 31, 2024.*

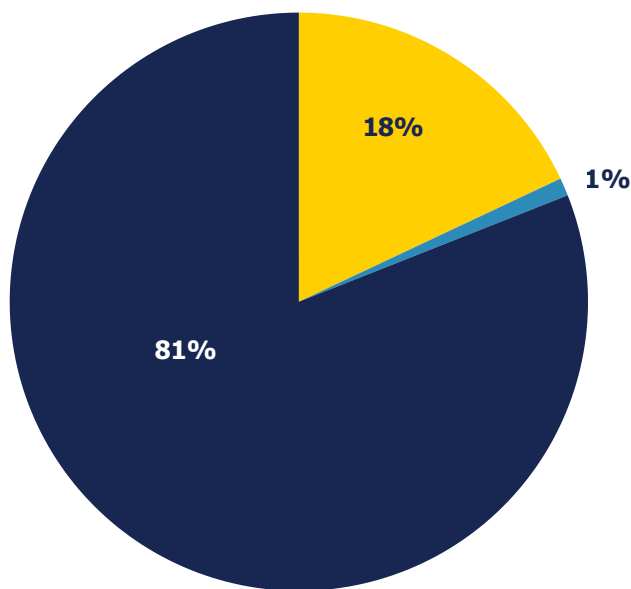

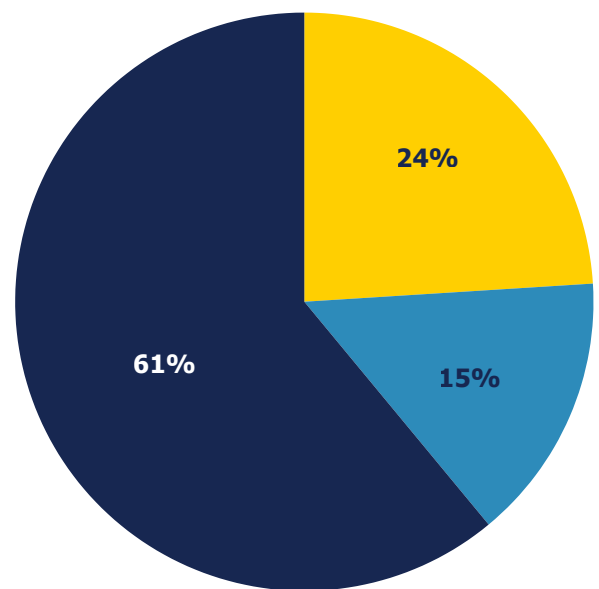
TOTAL REVENUE: \$289,758.27

End of Year Assets: **\$93,626.24**

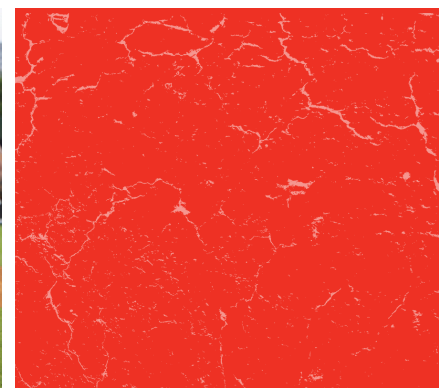
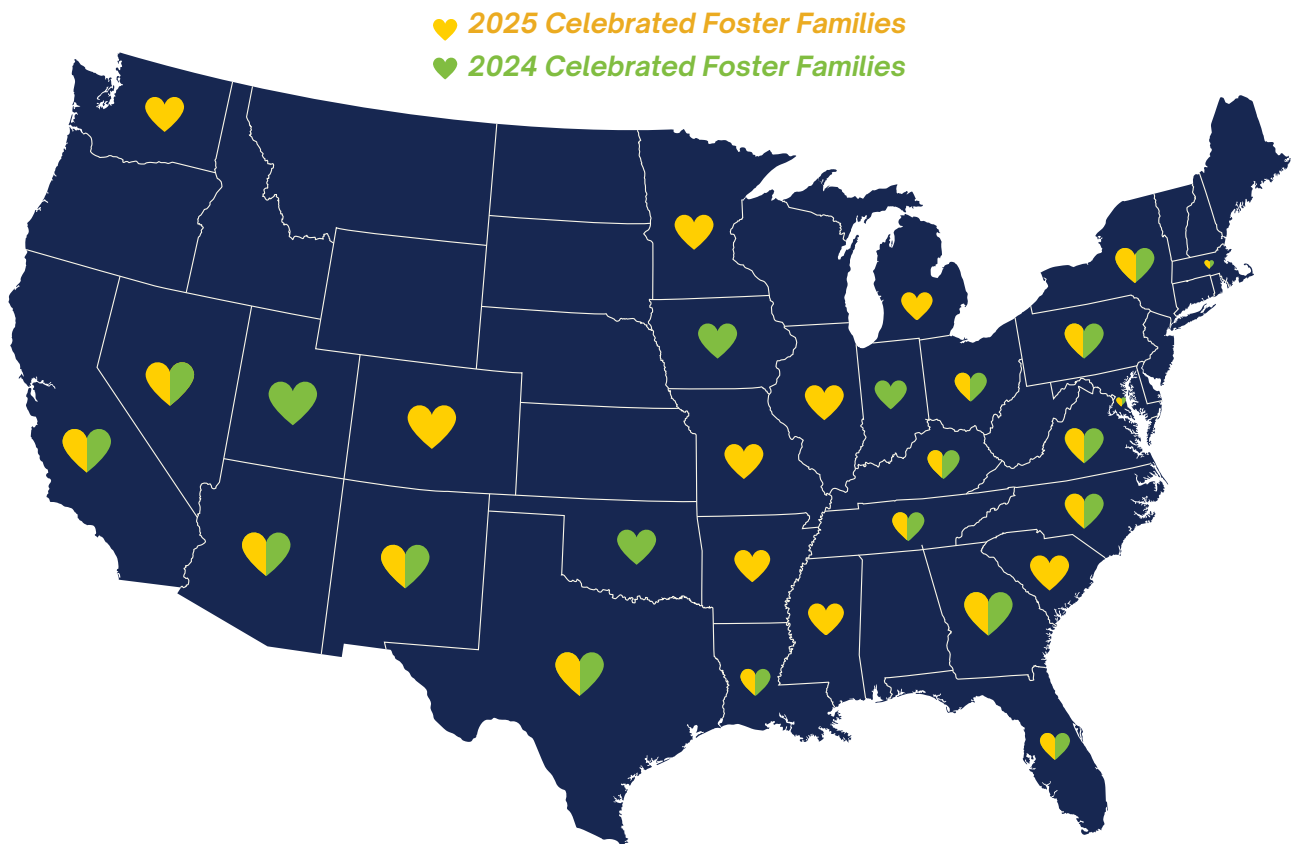

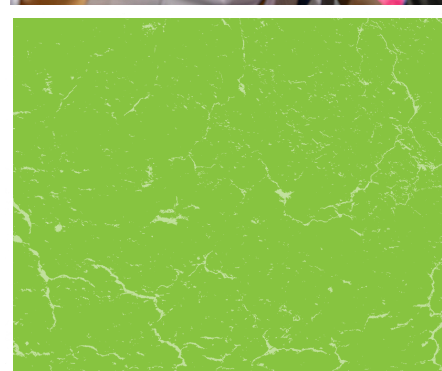
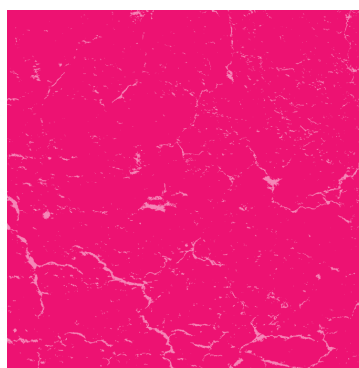
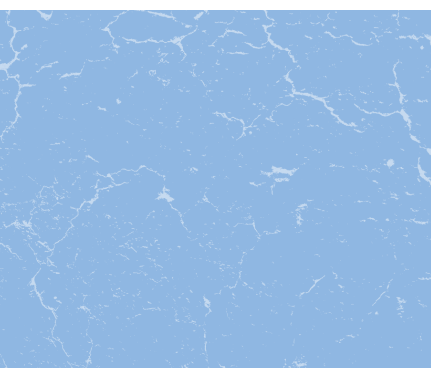
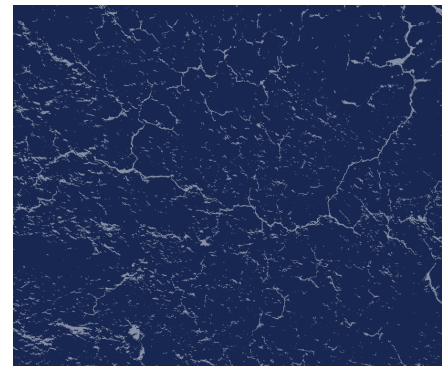


ON DECK: A LOOK AT 2025
